PENDAHULUAN

Saya berasa bangga merakamkan pendahuluan rancangan yang bersejarah ini. Padang Stadium ini telah menjadi cita-cita saya semenjak beberapa lama dahulu manakala saya berpendapat bahawa pekerja-pekerja yang berpuas hati ialah pekerja-pekerja yang akan bekerja dengan penuh semangat kecekapan. Satu keterangan yang rengkas bersangkutan dengan muncul atau timbulnya padang stadium ini serta munafaatnya kepada pekerja-pekerja Penjara adalah isi kandungan pendahuluan ini.

Padang Stadium yang luas dengan kemudahan-kemudahan bagi pergunaan sukan dan Olahraga adalah satu-satunya keperluan yang telah lama diidam-idamkan oleh pihak yang berkuasa Penjara. Boleh dikatakan bahawa Sukan adalah satu daya penarik yang istimewa kepada pekerja-pekerja dan kakitangan Penjara. Melihat kepada kecenderungan mereka yang meluap-luap itu nyatalah betapa mustahaknya diberi kepuasan-kepuasan yang dapat dipenuhi 'taklain dan takbukan ialah dengan mengikuti kemahuan mereka. Kepentingan mengadakan sukan ini dapat diduga dan dirasai bahawa sebahagian besar kehidupan Pegawai-pegawai Penjara adalah terkurban untuk perkhidmatan mereka di belakang dinding Penjara — Kehidupan yang agak terpisah daripada dunia masyarakat dan bekerja di dalam suasana yang amat memerlukan kesabaran yang tidak terhingga. Yang demikian tidaklah dihairankan bahawa pihak yang berkuasa penjara telah merasai insaf betapa pentingnya diberi kemudahan-kemudahan bagi mengadakan sukan sebagai melipurkan hati, menjaga kesihatan tubuh badan dan fikiran yang perlu untuk kecekapan di dalam sesuatu pekerjaan. Stadium yang telah tercipta di dalam impian saya dahulu telah pun terwujud sebagaimana yang ada ini.

Terbinanya Stadium ini ialah sebagai Lambang Perpaduan Pegawai-pegawai Penjara dan satu contoh yang baik bagi menunjukkan sesuatu pekerjaan itu boleh jadi tercapai dengan pertolongan diri. Tiap-tiap kakitangan Penjara dari Pesuruh Jaya membawa kepada serendah-rendah pelatih dari Pegawai kerani membawa kepada serendah-rendah Pegawai (Office Boy) sekeliannya menyahut dan memperbesar-besarkan bukan sahaja dengan memberi tenaga mereka bahkan dengan wang ringgit jua. Oleh kuat sangat desakan hati mereka pada hendak menjadikannya dengan seboleh-boleh, menyebabkan mereka -mereka bekerja dengan tidak menghiraukan masa atau pun cuaca. Ini, menunjukan bahawa cita-cita mereka telah tercipta. Saya berasa sangat megah dan berbesar hati dengan adanya pekerja -pekerja di bawah saya baik laki-laki mahu pun perempuan-perempuan bersatu hati untuk mencapai kejayaan yang istimewa dan diwaktu menjalankan kewajipannya mereka telah menunjukan semangat dan mutu yang tinggi.

Saya dengan sesungguhnya mengaku dan mengucapkan terima kasih di atas bantuan-bantuan dan pertolongan-pertolongan yang telah diterima amnya daripada ahli-ahli dermawan yang budiman yang mana tidak dapat saya sebutkan namanya tiap-tiap satu di dalam susunan Istia dat Pembukaan ini, demikian juga diucapkan terima kasih kepada Jabatan-jabatan Keraiaan yang telah memberi kemudahan-kemudahan khasnya kepada Jabatan Kerja Raya, Majlis Bandaran, Jabatan Sukat, Jabatan Hutan, Jabatan Pertanian dan Pejabat Kesihatan, Taiping.

It gives me great pleasure to write the foreword to this Souvenir Programme. That it should be a brief account of how this Sports Stadium came about and what it means to the Prison staff, is a dream I had a long time ago when I realized that a contented staff is an efficient staff.

The need for a Sports Stadium with ample facilities for sports and athletics has long been felt the desire of the Prison Authorities and it can be said that Sports hold a special attraction to those employed in Prisons whose zest and exuberance must be given outlet of this nature in view of their work. This can perhaps be explained better when it is realized that prison officers spend the greater part of their lives behind walls, to some extent cut off from the outside world, and working in an atmosphere that requires of them considerable patience and self control.
